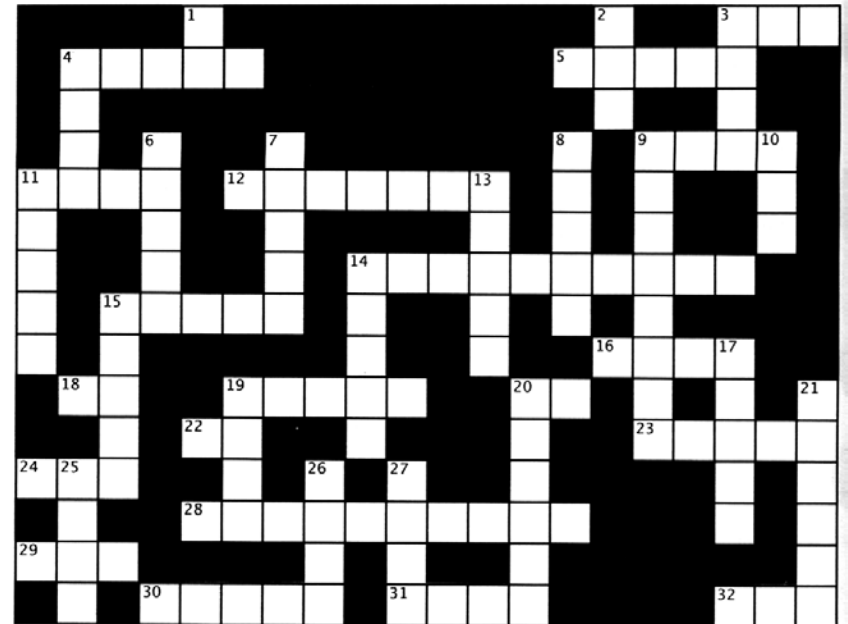
## Pasadena Mayor's Prayer Breakfast
