Membership and dues are an interesting enigma. While we had a great year in recruiting new members, 64, we also had a bad year in lost membership. We started the year 2014 at 1004 members and the




year 2015 at 946. Doing the math that is a loss of 58 members by death, demit or suspension. So to make up the loss for that, we need to recruit 58 to stay even next year but 116 to show growth. 116 is a good goal for new members next year. Two classes with at least 58 in each class would do the job.

Dues to date show 358 have paid their dues or 47%, while 400 are left to be paid, or 53%. 758 are the paying members. We have 247 members who are endowed life members, life members, or remitted dues. Lots of work to do this coming year and lots of surprises.
