




The next time the Box of Fraternal Assistance is passed around, please remember those who need our help and practice what we as Freemasons do best, ARK.

The end of the year report is in from Supreme Council. This is what the Valley of Pasadena looked like this last year.

We have decreased in strength to a small degree. Only two valleys had positive growth. The range in the loss column went from -2.5% to -26.8% . the Orient started 2014 with membership of 14,500 and ended 2014 with a membership of 13, 362 and over all loss of 1138 members or -7.8%.

I would love to see our valley post a positive growth number in 2015. Presently I have 120 members who are arrear in their dues by two years. If they have not paid their dues by then I will need to suspend their membership for non payment of dues. So we need to work on there membership and also work to bring new members in. I would venture to guess we will need at least 50 candidates for each class this year in order to reach positive growth. You my brothers are the source for bring forth a positive growth number.
